



GATHERING SAFELY

Your choice to attend service is voluntary. Please know that we continue **to livestream our Sunday services**, You are encouraged to continue to engage with our community **on-line**. If you choose to attend, we ask that you abide by the following:

By attending in person to our outdoor gathering, you agree and understand that;

- You are in a public setting with other individuals that are not related to you. As in any other public setting, there is a risk to be away from your home. Your participation is purely voluntary.
- While we believe that the church has a right to gather, please be advised that local law enforcement may decide to give personal citations to anyone they feel is non-compliant because there has not been any direction given to churches on how to gather.
- Be advised that you are to launder face masks and clothing after attending the service.

Guidelines

- If you, or a loved one in your home, or someone you care for is considered at-risk due to health issues, please do not attend and continue to participate in the on-line community.
- If you are in an age bracket that is considered at-risk, we ask that you stay at home and watch on-line.
- If you have any of the following: cough, fever, sore throat, difficulty breathing - please stay home, and seek medical attention as needed.
- If you have been exposed to anyone with the above conditions, we ask that you stay home and continue to participate on-line.
- All who attend are asked to: Please abide by social distancing while on-site. As we are meeting outdoors face masks are optional (as per current SBC guidelines) Wearing gloves is up to each individual. Hand sanitizer will be made available on-site.

Day of the Event:

- Please maintain social distancing at all times.
- Please park as directed by ushers
- Please follow usher instructions on where you can set up your pop up and or seats.
- Restroom access is limited at this time and ask that you plan to use restroom facilities in your own home before you come
